VIDEO SESSION: Narrator A

Nurigeul is a globalized version of *Hwunmin Cengum*, the Korean Alphabet of 1446. The genius of its letter design lies not only in its lucidly rationale structure, but also in its use of graphic shapes. Nurigeul accommodates the entire range of speech sounds, thus offering its universal applicability.

► Why Nurigeul is best fit for Literacy Program?

Since there exist one-to-one correspondence between the letter shape and its associated speech sound, we can transcribe the entire range of speech sounds by depicting the produced sounds and perceived sounds through Nurigeul. In other words as long as the phonetic information and associated physiological data are given, letter shapes can be generated accordingly. This generative Nurigeul can be applied to:

1. Literacy Program for Non-literate people
2. Creating scripts for the languages with no writing system
3. Transcribing the Bible in the languages of unreached people.
